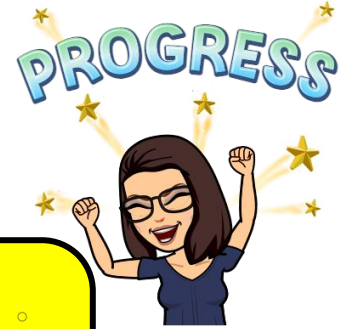

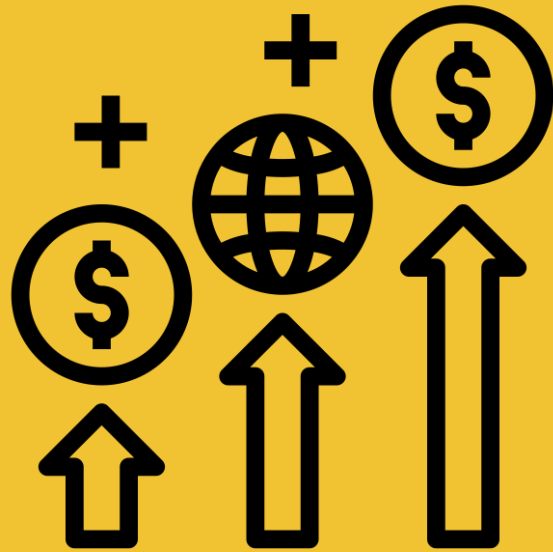

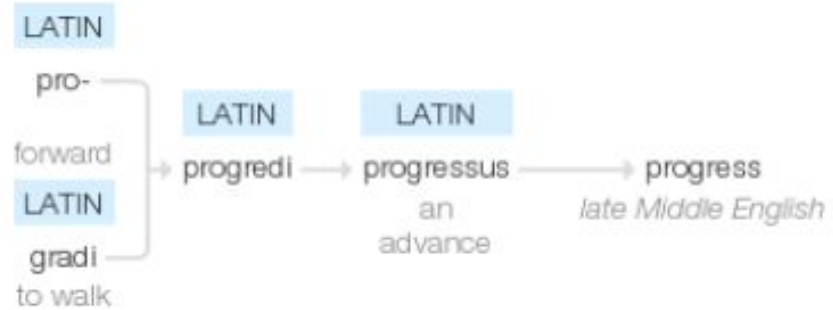

Definition

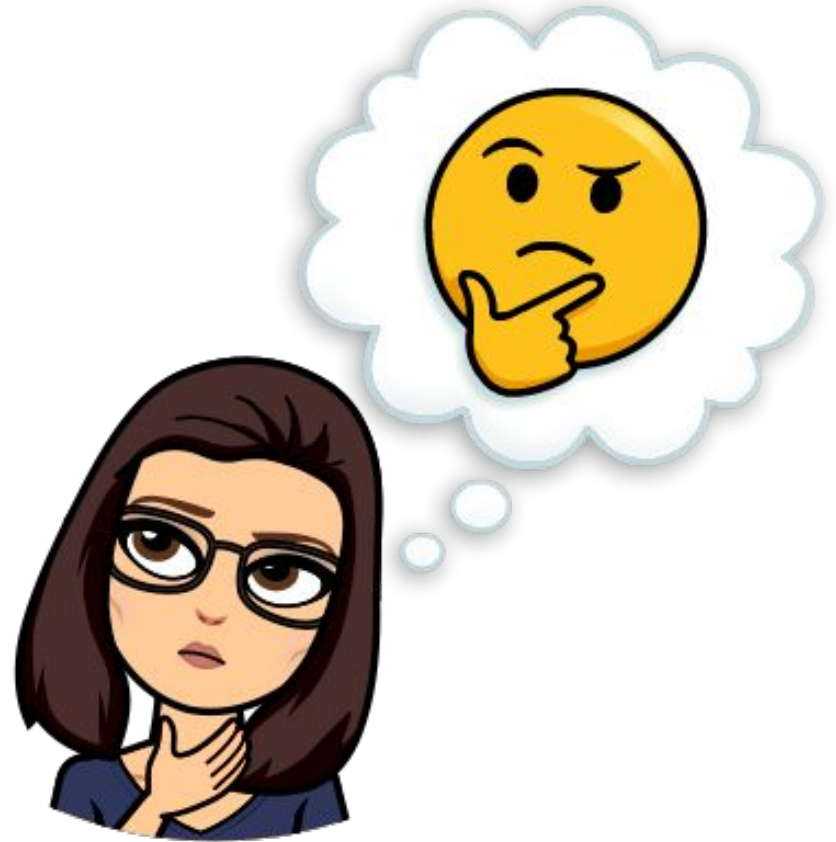

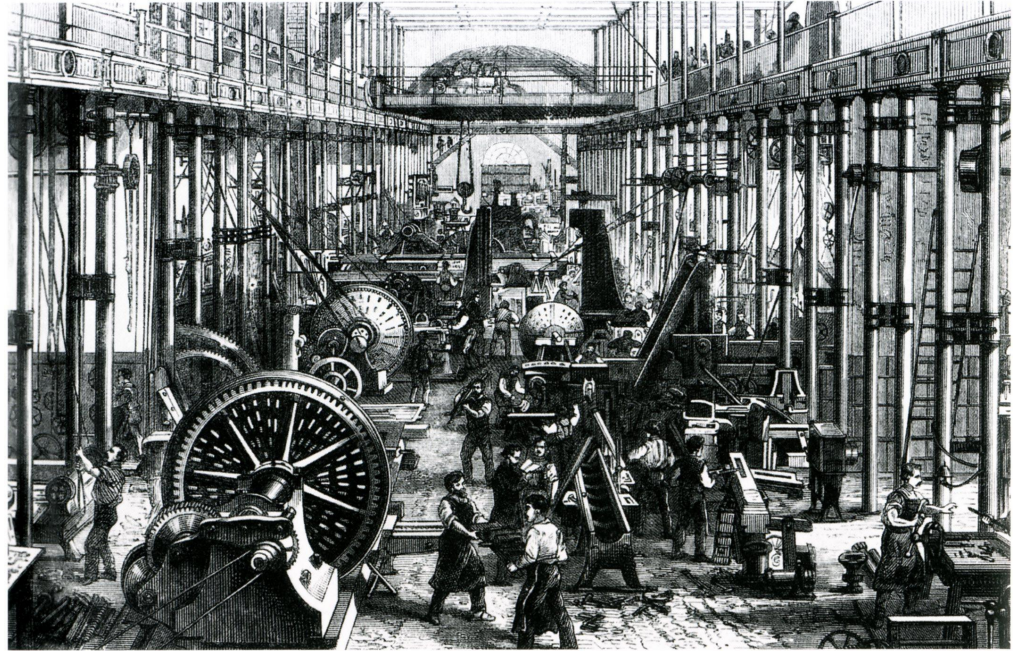

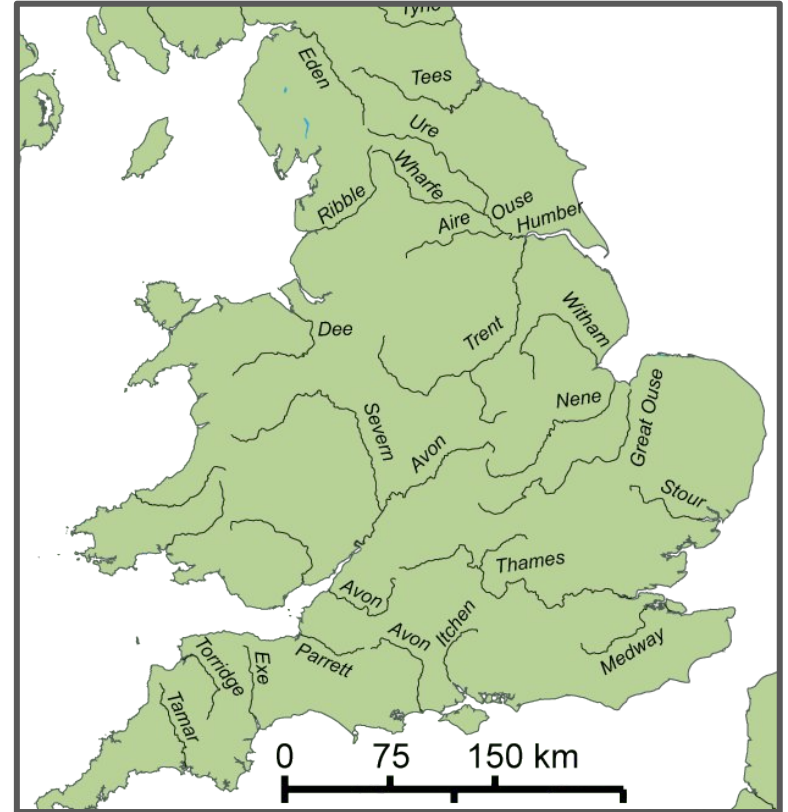
Causes of Industrialization

- 6. Stable Government**



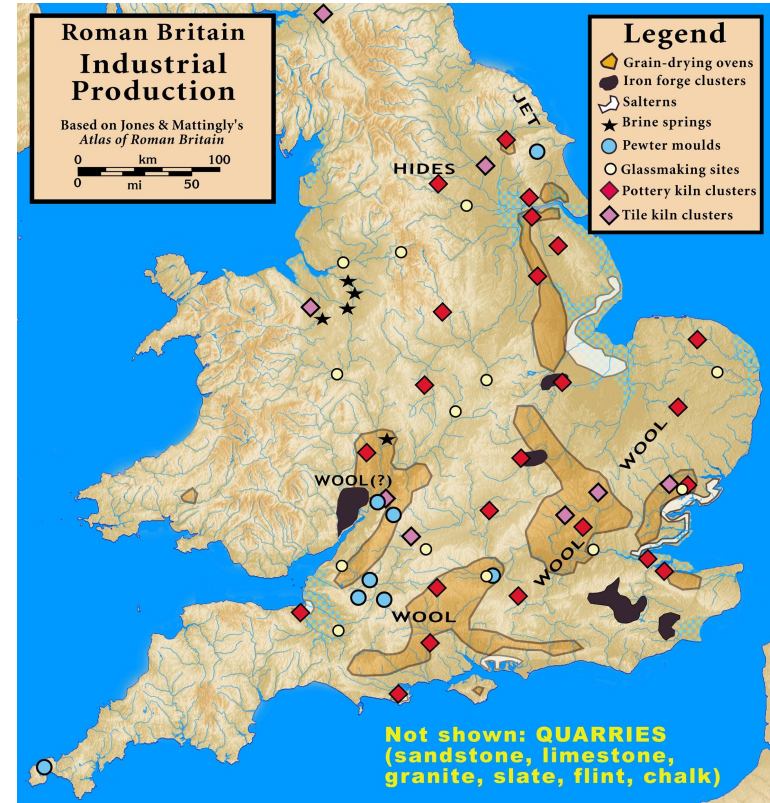
Geography

- **A country needs to have a geographical location that is conducive to rapid industrialization.**
- **Viable ports, rivers and streams help to accelerate the industrialization process.**



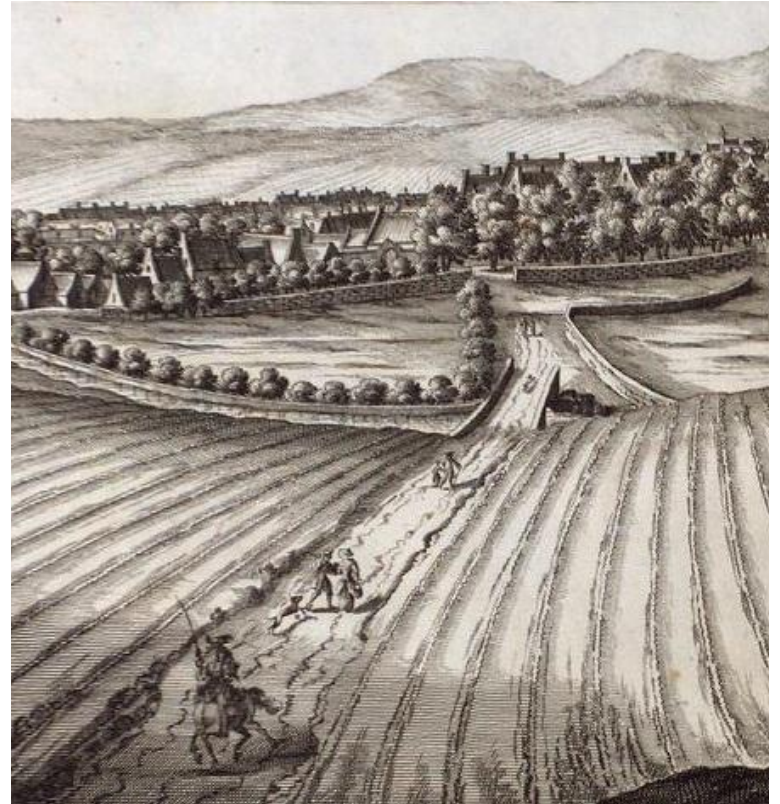
Natural Resources

- **Natural resources provide the raw materials necessary to build machines and factories and to manufacture goods.**
- **A country may tap into its own resources or obtain the necessary resources through their colonies or trade with other nations.**



Agricultural Revolution

- **Improved farming techniques and increased food production allows a country to grow in population.**
- **People are healthier, living longer and are able to work in the factories.**
- **Land consolidation forced people to move to cities.**
- **More people= more goods bought.**



Stable Government

- **No domestic wars**
- **Domestic trade not interrupted by conflict**
- **General trust and confidence in the government**
- **Government passes laws that protect businesses and encourage investment.**



Capital

- **Capital is money that is used to invest in businesses.**
- **Capital helps fund operations like shipping, mining, railroads, or factories and allows new businesses to be created.**



Entrepreneurship

- **Entrepreneurs invest and assume the risks of starting new businesses.**
- **They fund and support new businesses, inventions and help technology expand.**
- **As businesses/ technologies grew, they would make more money and then invest again.**
