# COURSE DESCRIPTION: "Students in grade ten study major turning

points that shaped the modern world, from the late eighteenth century through the present, including the cause and course of the two world wars. They trace the rise of democratic ideas and develop an understanding of the historical roots of current world issues, especially as they pertain to international relations. They extrapolate from the American experience that emocratic ideals are often achieved at a high price, remain vulnerable, and are not practiced everywhere in the world. Students develop an understanding of

current world issues and relate them to their historical, geographic, political, economic, and cultural contexts. Students consider multiple accounts of events in order to understand international relations from a variety of perspectives."


## HEALTH NOTICE

STUDENTS WILL BE GRADED FOR EACH LEARNING OBJECTIVE ON A 4-3-2-1-0 SCALE WITH A 4 EXCEEDING PROFICIENCY, A 3 DEMONSTRATES

PROFICIENCY, A 2 APPROACHES PROFICIENCY/BASIC KNOWLEDGE, A 1 IS BELOW
PROFICIENCY/EXPECTATIONS, AND A 1 LACKS ALL PROFICIENCY/NEEDS IMPROVEMENT. IN MY
CLASSROOM, THE FOCUS IS ON STUDENT LEARNING AND MASTERY OF THE CONTENT. FOR EACH
STANDARD, STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO EXPLAIN THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF THE LEARNING OBJECTIVES
RELATED TO A CONTENT STANDARD AND PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF THAT KNOWLEDGE BY EXPLAINING WHAT
WORK THEY HAVE DONE IN CLASS TO MEET THE CONTENT STANDARD AND LEARNING OBJECTIVES. THEIR
GRADE FOR THAT STANDARD WILL BE BASED ON THIS REFLECTION BY THE STUDENT AND TEACHER
EVALUATION OF COMPLETED FORMATIVE ASSIGNMENTS. IF A STUDENT DOES NOT EARN THEIR DESIRED
SCORE ON AN ASSESSMENT THEY ARE ELIGIBLE TO RETAKE IT ONCE THEY COMPLETE A RETAKE FORM.
STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE 3 STUDY TASKS AND PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF COMPLETED TASKS PRIOR TO
SCHEDULING A RETAKE. STUDENTS WILL USE THE RETAKE FORM TO SHOW THEY HAVE COMPLETED THE 3
TASKS AND TO SCHEDULE A TIME FOR A RETAKE.
