


14 Points

 - keep future peace




- German forces forced back







German Territorial Losses: 1919-1921




Versailles Settlement in Europe

Treaty Settlement	Problems
Because of the treaty, the new German Republic had to make large payments to pay for damage caused by the war.	These payments would hurt an already damaged German economy.
The treaty limited the size of the German military.	Germans resented the treaty demands.
The treaty created new states.	Some ethnic groups became unwanted minorities in the new states.
The treaty created a system of mandates.	Mandates added to imperial rule instead of ending it.
The treaty established the League of Nations.	The United States did not join, thereby weakening the League's power.
